AN OUTLINE OF A FUNERAL MASS

Introductory Rites*

At the entrance to the church the body is sprinkled with holy water and covered with a pall, a reminder of baptism. When the procession reaches the front of the church an open bible and a crucifix, symbols of Christian faith, are placed on the casket.

Prayers of the Faithful

Liturgy of the Eucharist

The Offertory* (Bread and wine are brought to the altar)

The Eucharistic Prayer

Final Commendation and Farewell

The body is sprinkled with holy water and honored with incense and the pall is removed.

You may wish to think of people from your family and friends who can:

- Read the 1st reading
- Read the 2nd reading (optional)
- Read the prayers of the Faithful
- Bring forward the gifts of bread and wine.

Readings at Mass

We encourage family and friends to take part in the Liturgy of the Word by reading the First Reading and Second Reading (optional) and the Prayers of the Faithful. Copies of the authorized readings are obtainable from the church. Other readings may be included in a vigil service.
